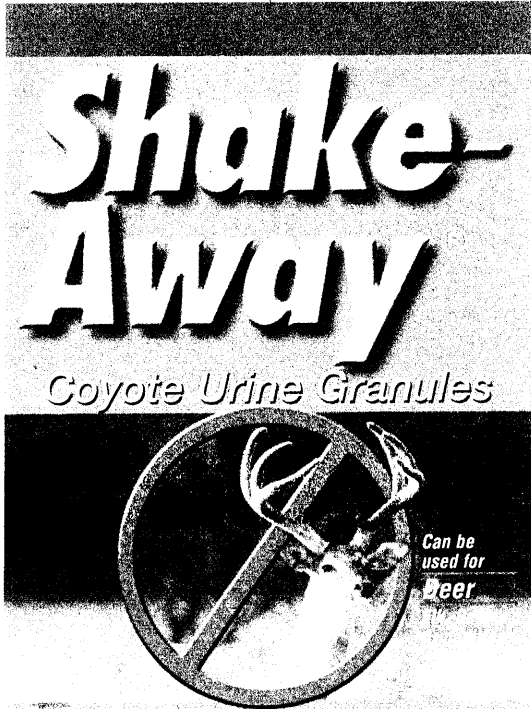

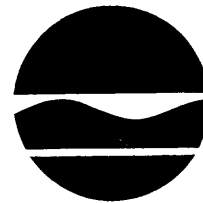

RE: Registration of Shake-Away Coyote Urine Granules (EPA Reg. No. 80917-1), Shake-Away Fox Urine Granules (EPA Reg. No. 80917-4), and Shake-Away Coyote/Fox Urine Granules (EPA Reg. No. 80917-5) Containing the New Active Ingredients Coyote Urine (Chemical Code 029007) and Fox Urine (Chemical Code 029008)

The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (Department) has reviewed your application to register the above-referenced pesticide products which contain the new active ingredients **fox urine and/or coyote urine**.

The application was deemed complete for purposes of technical review on June 19, 2008, and a registration decision was due by **November 16, 2008**.

Shake-Away Fox Urine Granules contain 5% by weight fox urine and is a granular product packaged in a 20 ounce container with directions to lightly sprinkle the product around yards and gardens where animals are causing damage, or to place two to four ounces in an open container and place the container in every 8 x 10 square foot area where animals are getting into attics, basements, garages and sheds to repel rabbits, gophers, groundhogs, possums, porcupines and woodchucks.

Shake-Away Coyote/Fox Urine Granules contain 3.5% by weight coyote urine and 1.5% by weight fox urine and is a granular product packaged in a 20 ounce container with directions to place two to four ounces in an open container and place the container in every 8 x 10 square foot area where animals are getting into attics, basements, garages and sheds. For outdoor use, the label directs the user to sprinkle it directly into every hole in the yard, flowerbeds, along foundations, etc., and poke a two-inch deep hole every three to four feet along tunnels of moles, and voles. The product is labeled to repel domestic cats, moles, voles and shrews.

Shake-Away Coyote Urine Granules contain 5% by weight coyote urine, and is a granular product that is sprinkled around the lawn or garden or flower bed perimeter to repel deer, elk, beavers, armadillos, javalinas and rabbits.

The registration of these products is based on the technical review received from the New York State Department of Health for impacts to human health.

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) waived all toxicity testing on the active ingredients and the formulated end products for federal registration given that they are comprised of naturally-occurring constituents and are not considered to pose a toxicity concern. The lowest toxicity category, "practically non-toxic," was assigned to all acute toxicity and acute irritation metrics, and they were not considered to be skin sensitizers. In addition, USEPA waived all subchronic, chronic, developmental/reproductive, and oncogenicity studies for federal registration of the Shake-Away products. The USEPA also did not require the registrant to submit any environmental fate or residue data, and exempted the requirement of a tolerance for residues of coyote and/or fox urine because it is not labeled for food use and it contains naturally occurring compounds. A comparative study between these active ingredients and dog urine concluded that there are no major differences in constituents. Our search of the toxicological literature found no additional data on the toxicity of coyote and/or fox urine.

The USEPA evaluation concluded that coyote and/or fox urine should not be very toxic or irritating following acute exposures. While exposure to urine (and other animal-derived materials) from laboratory and fur-bearing mammals has been shown to cause allergic reactions among workers, such risks to the general public from use of the Shake-Away products appears low due to the material being adsorbed onto a granular matrix and the limited direct exposure potential from the labeled use sites.

Based on the above-mentioned information, the Department accepts for general use registration in New York State Shake-Away Coyote Urine Granules (EPA Reg. No. 80917-1), Shake-Away Fox Urine Granules (EPA Reg. No. 80917-4), and Shake-Away Coyote/Fox Urine Granules (EPA Reg. No. 80917-5) containing the new active ingredients coyote urine and/or fox urine.

Enclosed are your Certificate of Registration and New York State stamped "ACCEPTED" labels. Shake-Away is reminded that if New York State registration is requested for this chemical which contains an expansion of use patterns, the product will be considered a **Major Change in Labeling and the Department will require an extensive review.**
