GENERAL INFORMATION

ALLIGARE Trace is a highly effective spray adjuvant designed to increase the effectiveness of aquatic, industrial, and agricultural herbicides. ALLIGARE Trace improves wetting, penetration and activation of broadleaf and woody plant species. ALLIGARE Trace is an environmentally safe by-product from the citrus industry.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Always follow the directions on the pesticide label carefully. The rates below are to be used only if they are not specified on the pesticide label. If the pesticide does not offer directions about mixing order, add **ALLIGARE Trace** as the last ingredient before making the final addition of water. Ensure thorough mixing by agitation or shaking.
