

GRANULAR REPELLENT **APPLICATION MOLE & VOLE**

MOLE APPLICATION NM Pro Repellent's formula absorbs into the ground to coat worms & bugs (their main diet) and makes their surroundings smell bad. These changes to their environment, drives them out of treated areas. IMPORTANT: DETERMINE WHICH DIRECTION YOU WANT THE MOLES TO LEAVE! The objective is to push the moles back to where they first entered. The amount of visible damage will show the entry/exit point.

RESIDENTIAL APPLICATIONS

Decide which direction you want to force them to an exit point off property.

APPLY Nature's Mace Pro Granular using a broadcast spreader at 60% Open. For specific brand of Spreader, see golf chart.

If damage is CLOSE TO THE HOME

DAY 1: Apply starting as close to the home as possible and cover the First Half Of The Yard. This will force the moles to start moving toward the exit location. Water in for 20 minutes.

DAY 3: Finish applying to the remainder of the yard. Water in for 20 minutes.

DAY 30: Apply 10 ft. perimeter band along the property line exit area to prevent their return. Water in for 20 minutes.

If damage is IN YARD, BUT NOT CLOSE to the home.

DAY 1: Form a half moon application starting 10 feet beyond the end of the runs and the damaged area. Cover the entire area (including the half moon

enter/exit property application) all the way to the exit line. Water in

for 20 minutes to activate, allowing it to soak into the soil, where worms are. **DAY 5:** Repeat by applying again to same area and water in.

DAY 30: Apply 10 foot band at property line exit to prevent return. Water in.

GOLF COURSE APPLICATIONS

BEFORE APPLYING:

Set Spreader based on the settings below OR adjust to 60% OPEN.

Recommended Settings will give 1 lb/650 sq. ft.

TO TREAT GREENS:

DAY 1: Apply around the Greens STARTING 2 feet from the edge of the green, extend the application 20 feet away. Water in for 20 minutes. (This will start the moles moving away from the green).

DAY 3: Extend the application another 20 feet and water in for 20 minutes. DAY 30: Apply a preventative barrier Only on the "Day 3 applied area". Water in for 20 minutes.

TO TREAT TEE AREAS



DAY 1: Apply repellent to entire tee extending 3 feet off of the mowed tee area. Water in for 20 minutes.

DAY 3: Apply to the sides of the tees at least 20 feet from the teeing area. Water in for 20 minutes.

DAY 30: Apply a preventative barrier ONLY to "Day 3 applied area". Water in for 20 minutes.

VOLE APPLICATION

Also known as Field Mice, are active all year, but cause the most damage in winter. They feed above & below the ground on plant parts. They ruin lawns, turf and ground cover including damaging runways/tunnels throughout the property. NM Pro Granular safely and naturally stops vole infestation when used as directed. APPLY starting in Mid-October & repeat application before first snowfall to prevent voles from entering property. Additionally, treat areas with a history of drifting and deep snow. If Vole damage is present, follow these steps.

BEFORE APPLYING: Set Spreader based on the settings at right OR adjust to 65% OPEN.



STEP 1: Scoop by hand, Nature's Mace Pro Granular in beds, mulch or rough grass, visibly enough to see.

STEP 2: Apply a 10" wide band around the perimeter

GENERAL APPLICATION: Apply 2 applications, 2 weeks apart to areas that are showing vole damage. Repeat again 30 days after second application. Spring **Application:** As snow melts, voles start looking for high grass areas to begin eating. Apply to those areas as it melts.
