DITRAC All-Weather BLOX is an extruded rat and mouse bait that gets excellent control indoors and out. Its active ingredient, Diphacinone, makes DITRAC All-Weather BLOX an excellent maintenance bait.

DITRAC All-Weather BLOX is formulated by a unique extrusion process that yields a highly palatable and weatherable bait. Made with the optimal blend of food-grade ingredients and paraffin, DITRAC All-Weather BLOX stays fresh and palatable in wet and dry areas.

DITRAC's patented X-shape design gives rodents plenty of edges to gnaw. This increased gnawing area, coupled with the special blend of ingredients, results in a bait that gets superior acceptance in all baiting situations. DITRAC is colored green and authorized by USDA for use in federally inspected meat and poultry plants.

Baiting is easy and clean with ready-to-use DITRAC All-Weather BLOX. The 1-oz. bait pieces fit easily into burrows, bait stations and tight baiting places. A quarter-inch hole through the center of the Blox lets PMPs place the Blox on bait securing rods or nail/wire them into place.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ THIS LABEL: Read this entire label and follow all use directions and use precautions.

IMPORTANT: Do not expose children, pets, or other nontarget animals to rodenticides. To help to prevent accidents:

1. Store product not in use in a location out of reach of children and pets.
2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals and nontarget wildlife, or in tamper-resistant bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and by children under six years of age, and must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. If bait can be shaken from stations when they are lifted, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Even stronger bait stations are needed in areas open to hoofed livestock, raccoons, bears, or other potentially destructive animals, or in areas prone to vandalism.
3. Dispose of product container, and unused, spoiled, and unconsumed bait as specified on this label.

USE RESTRICTIONS: For control of Norway rats, roof rats and house mice in and around homes, industrial and agricultural buildings, and similar man-made structures. This product is especially suited for wet or damp areas, such as river banks, gullies, irrigation ditches, sewers, garbage dumps and landfills.

Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: Determine areas where rats or mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been seen. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (Continued from other panel)

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

Each bait block in this container weighs approximately one ounce.

RATS: Place 3 to 16 DITRAC All-Weather BLOX (usually at intervals of 15 to 30 feet) per placement. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days or until signs of rat activity cease.

HOUSE MICE: Apply 1 block per typical placement. Space placements at 8- to 12- foot intervals. Two DITRAC All-Weather BLOX may be needed at points of very high mouse activity. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days or until signs of mouse activity cease.

RATS AND MICE: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all dead animals and leftover bait properly. To prevent reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water, and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store only in original container in a dry area inaccessible to children and pets.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty pail. Then dispose of empty pail in a sanitary landfill or by incineration or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
