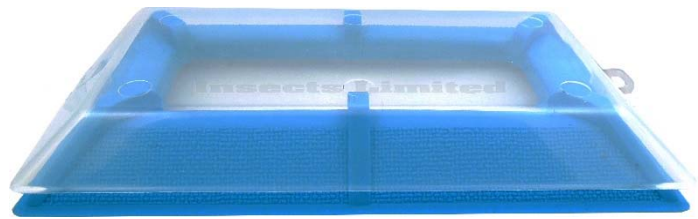








Assembly Instructions for All Beetle Trap

With **Dermestid Larval Food**

and **AA Bullet Lure** (For adult *Anthrenus*, *Attagenus* carpet beetles and other larval dermestid species)



<p>1) Pull the protective paper off of the sticky glue pad located inside the tray.</p>	 <p>1</p>
<p>2) Flip the blue base/clear cover upside-down and press the underside of the tray with the exposed glue board down firmly until it snaps into place. <i>You should be able to hear it snap into place on both ends of the tray.</i></p>	 <p>2</p>
<p>3) Remove the clear top from the blue trap base by gently lifting from the anchor point.</p> 	 <p>3</p>
<p>4) Place the AA Bullet Lure <u>and</u> the Dermestid Larval Food Attractant lure into the center of the glue board.</p> <p>(Note: The AA Bullet Lure will attract adult male varied carpet beetles and black carpet beetles. The Dermestid Larval Food Attractant will attract some adult female dermestid species looking to lay eggs as well as many other types of dermestid larvae.)</p>	 <p>4</p>
<p>5) Snap the clear top back onto the blue trap base and place the trap on a flat surface where dermestid activity is suspected. <i>Anchor the trap to displays, walls or floor when necessary.</i></p>	 <p>5</p>

6) Inspect the trap regularly. Add new pheromone lures as needed. Replace the glue board when it becomes more than 50% full of insects or debris as this may inhibit capture.
