

XLure F.I.T. -Fabric Insect Trap- Information & Instructions

INFORMATION:

Target Insects...

With the XLure-FIT you can specifically monitor for all of these fabric insects:

- Webbing Clothes Moth (*Tineola Bisselliella*)
- Casemaking Clothes Moth (*Tinea pellionella*)
- Black Carpet Beetle (*Attagenus unicolor*)
- Varied Carpet Beetle (*Anthrenus verbasci*)

How it works...

Once activated, the trap works by releasing pheromones which are airborne molecules that trigger a certain response in the insects. The pheromones attract males before they have a chance to mate with the females thus reducing the overall population. These pheromones are released at a steady rate over a 6-8 weeks. Male moths enter by keyholes on the upper surface of the trap, while beetle species crawl up the trap's rough surface which replicates the crack-like harborages they prefer. Moths and beetles land in the layer of glue that lines the bottom of the cartridge and die. (Cross section view in photo to the right)

INSTRUCTIONS:

Peel the aluminum foil from the cartridge. Push the cartridge onto the bottom of the trap to form the base. Place the trap on the floor of the potential area of infestation.

Examine the trap at regular intervals. Once full with insects, replace the cartridge with a fresh one. Replace cartridges every 6 – 8 weeks. Each cartridge is effective for 6 - 8 weeks. Dispose of used cartridges away from the monitoring area.

Use one trap in every room of suspected infestation or space at 27 – 33 feet intervals (8 -10 meters) .

XLure-FIT can be used anywhere, including public places and also dark, undisturbed areas where larvae often feed; homes, offices, apartments, museums, feather and carpet manufacturers; anywhere these insects are present.



STORAGE OF UN-USED TRAPS:

For storage up to, but not longer than 6 months, store where temperatures do not exceed 60°F (20°C)

For storage up to, but not longer than 12 months, refrigerate or store where temperatures do not exceed 50°F (10°C)

For storage 24 months and up, freeze at temps between 32°F - 40°F (4° C- 0°C)

HANDLING:

Handle traps and replacement cartridges carefully. Do not handle traps or cartridges after tobacco use. To avoid degradation/contamination of pheromones, avoid extensive contact with hands.
