German Roach Bait Placements

German roaches will exist under favorable conditions of food, water or warmth.

Before treating an area, it is best to first take a flashlight and check areas for harborage sites. Look for excrement (looks like black pepper)



Suggested Bait Placements

- 1. Behind kitchen cabinets and counter tops. (Pull the drawers out from under the counter top to expose the under surface of the counter top. Zig zag from front to back with bait placements about 12 to 18 inches apart. Afterwards, apply a few dabs to the back and bottom of the drawers before closing the drawers.)
- 2. Behind, next to, and under appliances such as the stove, refrigerator and dishwasher.(Pull out the refrigerator. German roaches love the warmth created by the motor; put a good number of bait placements on the back of the refrigerator as well as any cracks and crevices around it.)
- 3. In stored paper bags and boxes.
- 4. Around pipes, cords, and cables that come out of the wall.
- 5. Behind and under bathroom fixtures.
- 6. Behind the medicine cabinet and vanity.
- 7. In any cracks or crevices around shelves or wood trim.
- 8. Behind anything hanging on the wall, such as pictures, clocks, posters, etc.
