Crane Fly Larvae Control

Crane fly larvae cause significant damage to turf by feeding on the roots of grass plants. European crane fly overwinter as 3rd instar larva and will feed and cause damage in the spring, with peak damage occurring in May and early June from 4th instar larva. Adults emerge and lay eggs in July to September.

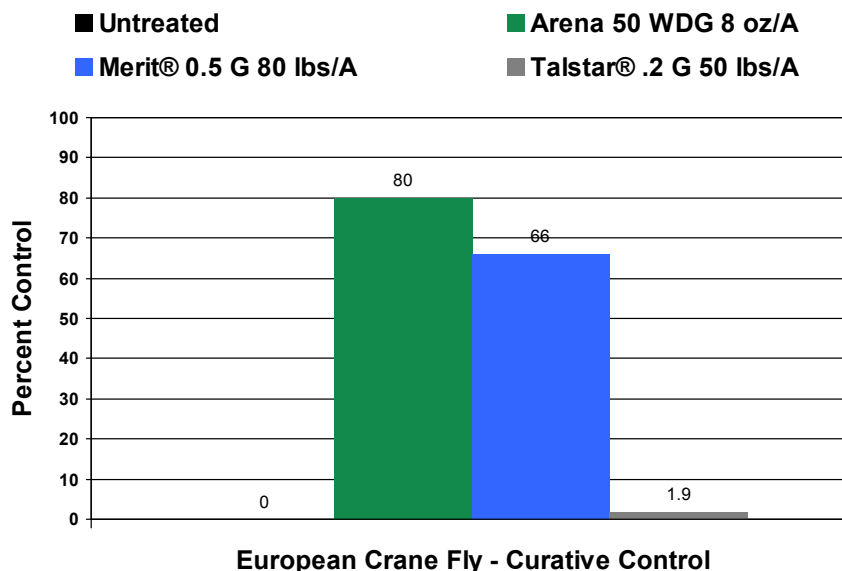
